Invitation to the crp2025 Conference at Wrocław University of Science and Technology

Dear Colleague,

We cordially invite you to the 43rd Conference of Rectors and Presidents of European Universities of Technology – crp2025 – to be held at Wrocław University of Science and Technology, Poland.

General background of the conference:

Following a joint initiative of the rectors of Vienna University of Technology and RWTH Aachen, this conference started in 1980 with the aim of establishing an informal platform for top representatives of leading science and engineering universities in Europe for:

- Discussing topics of major common concern, that are not discussed in other fora,
- Identifying differences and commonalities of existing solutions to problems of common interest,
- Developing new ideas and if appropriate preparing recommendations on specific topics,
- Forming a 'think tank' for the future development of the universities of technology in Europe.

The conference is organized as an informal platform, without a formal international governing structure.

The urgent challenge of addressing human-induced climate change calls for immediate action. Technical universities play a pivotal role in this endeavor by training future engineers and scientists, conducting ground breaking research and fostering innovation through spin-offs. As institutions, we must lead by example in addressing these significant ecological challenges.

Achieving net-zero greenhouse gas emissions within the next decades requires synchronized technical and societal transformations across multiple domains. Current efforts, while valuable, remain insufficient to meet the scale of the challenge.

The universities are developing cutting-edge research through multi-disciplinary collaborative approaches. The new technologies and the ultimate scientific discoveries have led to new treatments, new approaches for thinking and the development of new policy.

At crp2025, keynote speakers will provide diverse perspectives on the conference themes, while leaders of European universities of technology will share their strategies and experiences in transitioning their institutions toward climate neutrality.

Discussions at the 2025 conference will address issues such as:

- Smart spatial planning
- Adapted consumer behavior
- Sustainable construction materials and energy minimized production
- Optimized heating and cooling systems
- Smart building technologies
- Utilization of natural forms of energy and waste heat
- Forcing active mobility and public transport
- Green and blue infrastructure for the heat and water balance
- Global standards for certifying buildings and technical infrastructure
- System optimization by simulation and AI
- Environmental psychology and sociology

We are looking forward to meet you in Wrocław in September 2025!
